Q2 Nominees commitment to the organization

(25 POINTS)

Contribution you have made to the success of the organization.

TIPS

The emphasis should be on cost efficiency, Productivity, culinary excellence, training and development etc.

Q3 Nominees contribution to the industry

(15 POINTS)

Provide examples of your contribution that have significantly benefitted the industry.

TIPS

Industry affiliations, promotional activities both local and international, skills development programs and contribution towards sustainability etc.

Examples could include: conceptual development, operation, administration, management, regional Promotional and global promotional activities, research, advocacy, representation, improvement of Industry standards, participation in industry organizations, inclusive of challenging tasks-etc.



Q4 BENEFITS TO THE INDUSTRY AND SUCCESS
(20 POINTS)

Outline the degree of personal involvement, the success resulting from that involvement and the long- term benefits to the industry as determined by the ongoing nature of achievement or success.

(05 POINTS)

You may have several and please name those but single out one in detail.

(10 POINTS)

Please submit documentary proof of participation.

Q6 ANY COMMENDABLE AWARDS AND CERTIFICATES
(10 POINTS)

Please provide proof
